TO ALL OUR FRIENDS, FAMILY, & MINISTRY PARTNERS:

We want to thank you all for your continuous prayers and support for the mission in Peru. We wanted to provide an update with specific prayer requests. The government has just announced the extension of the state of emergency. This comes after multiple extensions and now the quarantine measures will continue (now for almost 7 months). In the quarantine areas, only one person per family will be allowed to leave the home during the designated non-quarantine hours and children under the age of 12 years old must remain at home. Children are only allowed out of the house for 60 minutes each day. Peru ranks second in the world with the highest mortality from COVID-19. Reports are estimating that over seven million people have lost their jobs. We ask that you pray for the hardships that the people in Peru are currently facing

under these strict measures during this worldwide pandemic.

Rooted In Grace and Love still has special permissions to deliver food to remote villages. We praise God for all the support and donations received to be able to continue to buy more food and supplies. Hundreds of families have been reached in the last few months. Prayers are greatly needed as the Peru mission team will begin to reach more families in **7 new designated villages** helping to distribute food, clothing, and much needed supplies. Our heart is to make JESUS known. **Pray as they will take the GOOD NEWS of JESUS CHRIST to each family - pray for many to put their faith in JESUS.**

GOD ANSWERS PRAYERS...

The Peruvian mission team has been busy traveling from village to village distributing Bibles, food, and much needed supplies. We have been praying as our Bible supplies have been running very low. We prayed for God to provide in the midst of this pandemic. Transportation is difficult and quarantine measures are still in place. In one of the villages, the mission team met one young man named Fredy. Fredy had walked from a nearby village, and when the mission team met him, all the food and supplies had been distributed to other families. Fredy made it very clear that he did not come for the supplies; he only asked for Bibles and tracts. His heart that day was to take God's Word back to his village. There were no more Bibles to give him, the team only had a handful of gospel tracts. Not having any Bibles to give him saddened the team greatly and they all began to pray.

When the team returned to Curahuasi, a close friend and neighbor brought a box of Bibles to donate to the ministry. This was an answered pray! Within days, a mission organization called AIDIA, pronounced like the English word "idea" whose main focus is translating the Bible into Eastern Apurímac Quechua, was able to get 400 more Bibles shipped to Curahuasi for the Rooted In Grace & Love mission team. We praise God for His faithfulness and provisions.

The international borders from the United States to Peru are still closed. We have been working with the passport officials since June to submit all documents for our new passports. During our repatriation flight to the States, all of our passports were terminated. At this time, we have received 5 of the 8 passports needed to travel. We were told this week that it may be 1-2 more months before the final 3 are approved. We ask that you please pray for the Lord to lead and direct our mission board and our ministry efforts in the coming months (both state-side and in Peru).
